Halakhic Corner

- Throughout the Ten Days of Repentance, one must insert the words "HaMelech HaKadosh" into the Amidah. If one forgets to do so, he must repeat the Amidah. This law also applies to the Maariv on the first evening of Rosh Hashanah. If one forgets, on the first night of Rosh HaShanah, he does not repeat.
- If a chazan should make a mistake and not say "HaMelech HaKadosh," he only needs to repeat the blessing of "Atta Kadosh".
- Rabbi J.B. Soloveitchik, Z"L, and most "Poskim" felt the Hazan should end the Amidah with the words "Hamevarech Et Amo Yisrael B'Shalom", and not "Oseh Shalom". We therefore follow this practice.

"Now is the time to say I'm sorry." With this in mind I found the following observations about apologies from the outstanding bestselling book, *The Last Lecture*, by the late Carnegie Mellon Professor, Randy Pausch, right on the mark.

"Apologies are not pass/fail". When giving an apology, any performance lower than an A really doesn't cut it. Halfhearted or insincere apologies are often worse than not apologizing at all because recipients find them insulting.

If you've done something wrong in your dealings with another person, it's as if there's an infection in your relationship. A good apology is like an antibiotic; a bad apology is like rubbing salt in the wound.

I'd start by describing the two classic bad apologies:

- "I'm sorry you feel hurt by what I've done." (This is an attempt at an emotional salve, but it's obvious you don't want to put any medicine in the wound.)
- "I apologize for what I did, but you also need to apologize to me for what you've done." (That's not giving an apology. That's asking for one.)

Proper apologies have three parts:

- What I did was wrong.
- I feel badly that I hurt you.
- How do I make this better?

Yes, some people may take advantage of you when answering question three. But most people will be genuinely appreciative of your make-good efforts. They may tell you how to make it better in some small, easy way. And often, they'll work harder to help make things better themselves. Students would say to me: "What if I apologize and the other person doesn't apologize back?" I'd tell them: "That's not something you can control, so don't let it eat at you."
